format:	<p>Sessions are 75 minutes long and should provide the audience with new skills or information that will increase their capacity to serve survivors of trafficking. Trainers should be interactive and engaging. Please note specific requirements for your presentation including projector, screen, microphone, and sound system. Laptops are not provided.</p>
submission process:	<p>Proposals will be accepted until <b>5 p.m. 10/1/19</b>. Submission does not guarantee acceptance. Those who submitted proposals will be notified via email of the status of their proposal by <b>10/31/19</b>. Selected speakers will be asked to commit by <b>11/30/19</b>.</p>
additional information:	<p>Presenters will receive complementary conference registration but will be expected to cover all travel expenses, including non-conference meals and hotel.</p> <p>Presenters will be expected to submit their presentation and supplemental materials by 2/24/20 for review.
